



Staggered approach

- ECB has published a document "ECMS User Testing Execution Testing Conditions" when ECMS functionalities become available for testing (planned fortnightly)
- ECMS functionality will become available after NCB's have tested the functionality and no blocking issues were encountered.
- A new version of the document has been published on the ECB-website last Friday.



Test activities by market participants – progress made



Connectivity test – progress made

Progress until 28 July 2023:

- > U2A connectivity: 28 out of 29 participants
- > A2A connectivity: 11 out of 13 participants

N.B.: unsuccessful connectivity is caused by ECMS-incidents, they have been reported and we are awaiting final decisions on resolving.

CTP2A progress: Dutch market

DNB performs 'Central Bank Testing': after successful completion release for CTP2A; mixed results due to several reasons:

- Known issue: no (active) securities account with ENL, alternatives suggested
- Problems with reference / static data within ECMS
- Testing environments not sufficiently stable
- Testing between DNB (and other ESES-NCB's) and Euroclear are going well
- First successful mobilisation of credit claim @CB-level

Test cases clear and understandable? Established contact with CSD('s) to prepare testing account and other prerequisites? Any issues?



CTP2A progress: Eurosystem

Status as of 28 July 2023

- No reporting yet from other Eurosystem markets, therefore no complete information
- NCBs report a variety of results, comparable to the NL situation. Overall progress is (too) slow due to reported incidents and instable testing environment.
- Also apparently unforeseen activities with and by national CSDs: establishing testing accounts and availability of ISIN to be used in testing environment of T2S. Hopefully improvement at short notice.

- → Question: Is it (already) possible to perform a test transaction by moving securities from Pool 1 to Pool 2 (or vice versa)?
- → Answer: Unfortunately, this functionality –i.e. multipooling- is not available yet in Utest. NCBs are testing this on EAC, with various results. We will inform you as soon this has been released for community testing.

SWIFT MyStandards

- ECMS actors that interact with the ECMS via A2A can request access to the ECMS group in the MyStandards web application.
- CPTYs can verify/test the compliance of message versions in the Readiness Portal,
 with specifications provided in MyStandards.

The portal is a web application built on top of MyStandards.

- Tests with the MyStandards Readiness Portal neither require nor verify the connectivity via ESMIG.
- MyStandards Readiness Portal neither allows to reach nor test the ECMS.
